- Install High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST) on the pavement surface. This work activity will include cold planning 0.2' of existing AC and replaced with 0.2' RHMA prior to placing the HFST
- Upgrade the existing pavement delineation to meet current standards and add pavement marker to deter Wrong Way entry onto off-ramp.
- Remove/replace and improve existing signage and markings, specifically:
 - → Install approximately 960 feet of speed reduction markings (SMR).
 - → Install WI 3-2 (EXIT) sign just beyond the gore point.
 - → Remove W4-14(CA) & W3-3 signs & install WI-11 & W13-1P signs.
 - \rightarrow Remove W4-14 (CA) and install W4-10 & W3-3 signs.
 - → Relocate G11-4.1(CA) sign to the front of the Magnolia St. overpass abutment.
 - → Remove Type V arrow pavement marking at the existing location and install the Type V arrow pavement marking.
 - \rightarrow Install R61-22(CA) MOD signs on the left-hand side at the beginning of the U-shaped curve of the off-ramp.
 - → Install DI-2 & R61-22(CA) MOD signs on the right-hand side at the beginning of the U-shaped curve of the off-ramp.
 - → Install Type II (L & R) arrow markings at the beginning of the U-shaped curve of the off-ramp.
 - → Replace R61-22(CA) MOD on the left-hand side located within the U-shaped curve of the off-ramp at the I-5 NB to SR 91 connector overpass.
 - → Remove DI-2 sign on the right-hand side located within the U-shaped curve of the off-ramp at the I-5 NB to SR 91 connector overpass and install R61-22(CA) MOD.
 - → Remove R61-66(CA) MOD signs on the left-hand and right-hand sides located at the end of the ramp terminus and install R5-l0c signs facing the opposite direction of travel.
 - → Remove W74(CA) and install W73A(CA).
 - → Install Type IV (R) arrow & "ONLY" markings.
 - → Install W3-3 sign on the luminaire of Magnolia St. NB approximately 300 feet downstream from W73(CA) sign.
 - → Install Type IV (R) arrow marking.
 - → Install R3-7 sign.
 - → Replace G21-3 MOD sign and post on the right-hand side of Magnolia St. SB located at SR 91 WB & 1-5 NB HOV connector undercrossing.
 - → Install W3-3 sign on Magnolia St. SB located at SR 91 EB overpass.

The Estimated Disturbed Soil Area (DSA) for this project is less than one acre. All work will occur in State's existing Right of Way (R/W). A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) is needed and will be coordinated with City prior to start of Construction. Temporary ramp lane closures are anticipated, and night work is possible. Construction is expected to last up to six months and will begin approximately February 2024.

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No significant environmental consequences are anticipated with the proposed project. In addition to the Caltrans Standards and Measures relating to Construction Noise, Air Pollution Control, Erosion Control and Hazardous Waste, the following Measures are required:

 An Environmental Commitment Record (ECR) has been prepared. The ECR contains Measures that will be addressed and implemented during Design and Construction Phases.
