<u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u>

Union Pacific Railroad Company will conduct response action activities under the U.S. EPA Order for Removal, Mitigation, or Prevention of a Substantial Threat of Oil Discharge (CWA 311 09-2021-0002). Activities to be completed in 2022 will include an inland extension of the 2021 response action and preparation for future full-scale excavation in 2023-2024. Work in waters of the U.S. in 2022 will be limited to temporary access for debris boom installation/removal and retaining wall support. An approximately 12-foot wide by 450-foot-long area between stations 12+50 and 17+00 (0.12 acre) will be used for temporary access in 2022. Future full-scale excavation activities anticipated to occur in 2023 are not included in this Project.

Class 30 consists of any minor cleanup actions taken to prevent, minimize, stabilize, mitigate, or eliminate the release or threat of release of a hazardous waste or substance which are small or medium removal actions costing \$1 million or less.
