Project Title: State Route 180 Two-Way Left-Turn Channelization (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-FRE-34288-R4)

Project Location: The project is in Fresno County on State Route 180 between postmile 89.6, located 0.4 mile east of George Smith Road and postmile 90.7, located near Elwood Road in Yokuts Valley.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-FRE-34288-R4), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

Caltrans proposes to widen the south side of State Route 180 by 15 feet and install a two-way left-turn lane within the project limits. Other work will include upgrading drainage systems through the project limits and installing one traffic monitoring station system.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 7/13/2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
