**Project Title:** Sacramento River Trail Repairs Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SHA-37875-R1)

**Project Location (Shasta):** The project is located along the Sacramento River within the City of Redding; Sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, and 35, Township 32N, Range 5W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Redding, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS-SHA-37875-R1, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, City of Redding.

The project is limited to repairing seating and viewing areas, trail surfaces, trail embankments, and trail shoulders along the Sacramento River Trail. Specific work includes vegetation removal, demolition, excavation, grading, sediment removal, culvert cleaning, paving, concrete repair, bench replacement, placement of rock slope protection (RSP), vegetation planting, and hydro-seed application.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on January 25, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

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1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
