Project Description
Caltrans proposes to place micro-surfacing as a form of preventative maintenance on Highway 101 from post mile R100.1 to R106.8 from South Fork Eel River Bridge 10-300 to the Mendocino/Humboldt County line.
The work will occur over approximately 30-40 working days and consists of replacing asphalt concrete surfacing, placing crack treatment, removing existing stripe and pavement markers, placing micro-surfacing, placing shoulder backing on existing shoulder backing (at locations with existing low shoulders at edge-of-pavement (EP), replacing rumble strips, and replacing pavement delineation. All work will be within the existing State right of way. Equipment staging will be confined to paved surfaces and existing non-vegetated turnouts. There will be no tree removal. Environmental reviews were conducted for air quality, noise, greenhouse gases, visual, water quality, biological resources, cultural resources, and determined to have no significant impacts on the environment.
