

Notice of Availability

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has prepared an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the State Route (SR) 37 Petaluma River Bridge Project in Marin and Sonoma Counties.



What's being planned: Caltrans has prepared an IS/MND for the SR 37 Petaluma River Bridge Project (Project). The Project is located in Marin and Sonoma Counties, California, on SR 37 at post mile (PM) 14.5 from Harbor Drive to near Sears Point Road. The Project proposes rehabilitation of the bridge deck, replacement of the bridge fender system, bridge scour protection, and upgrading the bridge railings to meet current safety standards and maintain the structure in a reliable and serviceable condition.

Why this ad: Caltrans, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), has prepared the IS/MND to analyze potential effects the proposed Project may have on the environment. This notice is to inform you of the public comment period.
