The proposed project is located north of Federal Boulevard and west of 47th Street and divided in two portions that are separated by a driveway/access road to a distribution center. The smaller portion of the project site occurs on the eastern side and is proposed for employee parking and an administration/operation building, and the larger portion occurs on the western side and is proposed for bus parking/charging, maintenance bays, bus washes, and an operations building. Access to the project is proposed to be located at up to four driveways along the Federal Boulevard project frontage.
