Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).				
The Project consists of a request to allow the construction of a 90,566-square-foot industrial building for Pentair Pool Products, on approximately 5.65 acres of land (Assessor 's Parcel Number [APN] 511-0-200-265). The existing site is vacant and would include removal of the existing vegetation. The Project will include the development of a new driveway with reinforced concrete box culvert, parking, landscaping, new warehouse facility, and associated site improvements. The Project site will include 185 parking spaces, including 6 accessible stalls, 137 standard stalls, 19 electric vehicle (EV) stalls, and 23 clean air/van pool stalls. The site will also feature 20 bicycle racks and 3 motorcycle parking stalls.				

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Mitigation measures are provided for biological resources, cultural resources, and traffic:

For nesting birds, MM-BIO-1 is provided that require a nesting bird pre-construction survey three days prior to demolition and/or vegetation removal activities during nesting bird season (February 15 through August 31) as well as having appropriate buffers established if nests are found. For cultural resources MM-CUL-1, would provide an archeologist to be present during ground disturbing activities; MM-CUL-2, would require the preparation of a monitoring report for all archeological monitoring completed during construction. For traffic, MM-TRA-1, would require the applicant to provide a vanpool program with 12 minimum employee participation or implement a similar program resulting in a similar VMT reduction.
