PROJECT TITLE: Predator Proof Trash and Recycling Infrastructure **LOCATION:** Sue-meg State Park **COUNTY:** Humboldt

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace all trash and recycling receptacles within Sue-meg State Park with predator proof versions and securely fasten to new concrete pads to reduce unwanted encounters with bears and the unintentional feeding and attraction of wildlife. Replace worn service items with new ones following State Parks Accessibility Guidelines. Work will:

- Replace twenty-one (21) trash receptacles with new predator proof receptacles and securely fasten to concrete pads;
- Where needed, surface pour new 100 inch long by 45 inch wide concrete pads to anchor two (2)
 "side by side" containers and 50 inch long by 45 inch wide pads to anchor a single "side by side"
 container; and
- Use new anchor bolts to securely fasten a total of eleven (11) existing trash receptacles and three (3) recycling containers that are still in serviceable condition to new or existing concrete pads.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the operation, repair, maintenance or minor alteration of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; and construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures.
