The data collected during pumping and injection tests will be used to refine current groundwater model parameters and to determine baseline basin groundwater quality in the zones where future injection wells are planned to be constructed. The monitoring well will be placed at a targeted location to better refine estimates of aquifer characteristics, mounding effects, and travel times. Results from this study will be used to select the optimal placement of the remaining four proposed injection wells that will be constructing in this phase (Phase 1). Phase 2 proposes to install two recovery wells. This system includes the injection of approximately 2,500 AFY of fully treated (reverse osmosis) recycled water to provide additional drinking water supplies and to meet peak recycled water demands by reversing the flow of water from the injection wells. Implementation of this Phase 2 will also provide purified recycled water recharge to Yucaipa Subbasin and recovery facilities, thus decreasing dependence on imported water deliveries. RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE YUCAIPA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Yucaipa Valley Water District (the "District") is a public agency of the State of California organized and existing pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law of this State (Section 30000, et seq. of the Water Code); and

WHEREAS, the District is responsible for the construction and maintenance of water, recycled water and wastewater facilities within the District's service area; and

WHEREAS, the District is utilizing recycled water to recharge local groundwater basins to increase local water supply reliability.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Yucaipa Valley Water District hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE, and ORDER as follows:

- 1. The Board of Directors hereby finds that approval of the Project is not subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code §21000 et seq. and the State CEQA Guidelines, California. Article 5, 15062 Notice of Exemption.
- 2. The construction of the recycled water reservoirs is classified under Class 3(d), Section 15303 New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures.
- 3. The Board of Directors hereby directs District staff to file a Notice of Exemption for the project within five working days of approval of the Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project
- 3. The Board of Directors hereby approves the construction of the Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project and directs the General Manager to file the Notice of Exemption with the County of Riverside and the Office of Planning and Research.
