RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE YUCAIPA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE YUCAIPA VALLEY RECYCLED WATER RESERVOIRS R.12.5

WHEREAS, the Yucaipa Valley Water District (the "District") is a public agency of the State of California organized and existing pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law of this State (Section 30000, et seq. of the Water Code); and

WHEREAS, the District is responsible for the maintenance of water and wastewater facilities within the District's service area; and

WHEREAS, the District is expanding the recycled water infrastructure throughout its service area to improve water sustainability.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Yucaipa Valley Water District hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE, and ORDER as follows:

- The Board of Directors hereby finds that approval of the Project is not subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code §21000 et seq. and the State CEQA Guidelines, California. Article 5, 15062 Notice of Exemption.
- 2. The construction of the recycled water reservoirs is classified under Class 3(d), Section 15303 New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures.
- 3. The Board of Directors hereby directs District staff to file a Notice of Exemption for the project within five working days of approval of the R.12.5 Recycled Water Reservoirs.
- The Board of Directors hereby approves the construction of the R.12.5 Recycled Water Reservoirs and directs the General Manager to file the Notice of Exemption with the County of Riverside and the Office of Planning and Research.
