Project Location - Specific: The project site is on the south side of E. Harney Lane, 1.3 miles east of State Route 88,

east of Lodi. (APN/Address: 063-260-16 / 13294 E. Harney Ln., Lodi) (Supervisorial District: 4)

**Project Description:** Minor Subdivision application to subdivide an existing 17.3-acre parcel into 2 parcel and a Designated Remainder. Parcels 1 and 2 to contain 5 acres each. The Designated Remainder will consist of 7.3 acres. Access to Parcels 1 and 2 is proposed from E. Harney Ln. via an existing road easement crossing the designated remainder, which has direct access from E. Harney Ln. Each parcel will utilize onsite wells and septic systems. Storm water drainage is natural. This parcel is not under a Williamson Act Contract.

The Property is zoned AL-5 (Limited Agriculture, 5-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/L (Limited Agriculture).
