The northern segment is currently zoned C-1 Neighborhood Commercial District and R-3 High Density Multiple-Family Housing with a land use designation of Commercial and Parks. The southern portion is currently zoned M(O) Manufacturing with a land use designation of Low Density Residential.

YLWD constructed a new, large water treatment plant known as Plant 1 or PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances) Water Treatment Plant at its headquarters, which is currently in service. Due to the high volume of water feeding into and exiting the plant, YLWD can no longer use its existing pipeline in Richfield Road to transport water both to and from the area of the plant. Therefore, YLWD proposes to construct a new water pipeline (new waterline) to transmit water to loop the water system and provide water system redundancy.
