Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SIS-32872-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mr. Donald Erickson in conjunction with Emergency timber harvest notification # 2-22EM-00166-SIS-R1 previously approved by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection.

The project is limited to (1) encroachment total which authorizes placement and removal of a temporary steel bridge across Boulder Creek to facilitate access to fire damaged timber stands and repair damaged roads on private timberlands from wildfires that occurred in 2021. The bridge is currently in place and being used by adjacent landowner Mr. John McDonagh under existing LSA permit # EPIMS-SIS-29254-R1. Mr. Erickson will take over responsibility for maintenance and removal of this bridge at the end of his timber harvest operations in Fall 2022 per written agreement between the two parties.
