
Comments will be accepted from August 18 to September 19, 2022. If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to maintain 14.41 lane miles of existing roadway on U.S. Route 101 in Santa Barbara County between 0.4 mile south of Santa Rosa Road and 0.1 mile north of Nojoqui Creek. The project would also replace asphalt concrete dikes, rebuild existing guardrail, upgrade guardrail connections to bridge railing, improve five drainage systems, and repair a failing slope.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This



notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
