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#### **Continuation sheet:**

All work will be confined within the existing roadbed hinge point. This project will not include removal of thermoplastic pavement marking as a separate process. No bridges or guardrails are within the project limits. Cold planing of the asphalt will be required to match existing roadway features, and shoulders will be backed to standard. The project would be constructed in 2023 and take approximately 30 working days.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the project is to provide efficient, easily maintained pavement that provides minimum maintenance for multiple years, as well as increase safety for travelers and workers.

**Need:** The pavement has degraded to a point where maintenance is required to extend its service life.

### Right-of-Way

Acquisitions or TCEs will not be needed for this project due to work being confined to ROW.

### Staging/Stockpiling

Multiple locations are available for staging/stockpiling use. No grading and/or site preparation will occur. Approved staging locations include: PM 32.2 SB, PM 34.7 NB, PM 38.23 NB, PM 38.25 SB.

### **Disposal/Borrow Sites**

The project would not utilize borrowed material. The contractor will be responsible for disposal of excess material.

#### Coordination/Consultation

Based on the scope of the project, no outside coordination or consultation was carried out/required.

#### **Permits**

No permits are necessary with current scope of work.

#### **Utilities**

All utilities in proximity to the locations of work would be protected in place; no utility conflicts are anticipated.

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
