The biology report determined that the on-site habitat supports special-status wildlife species, in particular desert tortoise (Gopherus agassizii) and burrowing owl (Athene cunicularia) as well as special-status plants.

- 1)To address potential impact to nesting and sensitive bird species, a pre-construction survey is required mitigation measure, per Mitigation Measure Bio-1.
- 2) To address potential impacts to desert tortoise a per-construction clearance is require, along with education programs, reduce speed limits and a limit on the amount of disturbance required, per Mitigation Measure Bio-2.

Potential impacts to on-site Regional Board waters of the State and CDFW jurisdiction streambed will likely require a Regional Board Report of Waste Discharge permit prior to project implementation and a CDFW Section 1602 Streambed Alteration Agreement

To address stream alteration concerns, a juridictional delineation survey is required.

There is a possibility of discovering human remains during operation. Therefore, four mitigation measure were included to address potential impact, CR-1, CR-2 and CR-3 and Geo 1.
