

**Brief Project Description:** The 2022 AQMP is a comprehensive policy document that presents a combined local and state clean air strategy based on concurrent reactive organic gases (ROG) and nitrogen oxides (NOx) emission reductions to bring Ventura County into attainment of the 2015 federal 8-hour ozone standard as mandated by the federal Clean Air Act. ROG and NOx emitted by both anthropogenic and natural sources react in the atmosphere to produce photochemical smog, of which ozone is the principal constituent.

Ventura County continues to make great progress towards meeting federal clean air standards for ozone by a steady decades-long decrease in countywide ozone levels. In 1990, Ventura County had 18 days over the now revoked federal 1-hour ozone standard. However, by 2003 there were only two days over that standard, and none in 2004 and 2005. The previous Ventura County AQMP, prepared in 2016, projected attainment of the 2008 federal 8-hour ozone standard by 2020. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published a notice of proposed rulemaking on July 14, 2022, determining that Ventura County has attained that standard by its July 20, 2021 attainment date. This progress is expected to continue under the 2022 AQMP for the 2015 federal ozone standard.

The 2022 AQMP does not include or propose any components, measures, actions, projects, or regulations that would adversely impact biological resources in the county. Biological resources of many types are sensitive to air pollution, especially photochemical air pollutants such as ozone. Therefore, the 2022 AQMP is expected to benefit wildlife in Ventura County by further improving air quality, atmospheric visibility, and overall health.

**Determination:** Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee. This determination does not in any way imply that the project is exempt from CEQA and does not determine the significance of any potential project effects evaluated pursuant to CEQA.
