The Project Applicant proposes a General Plan Amendment, Zone Change, and Specific Plan to facilitate the development of an 433.7-acre property located south of East Avenue M/Columbia Way and east of Sierra Highway in the City of Palmdale with up to 8,263,332 square feet (SF) of Industrial (IND) building space and approximately 61,855 SF of Commercial Flex (C-F) building space. Industrial building users are expected to be a mixture of manufacturing, warehousing, parcel hub, fulfillment center, light industrial and associated uses on 379.4 acres. Commercial Flex building users are expected to include commercial retail with accommodations for small-scale manufacturing and sales on 7.1 acres. In addition, 26.8 acres of open space and 20.4 acres of roadway are proposed. A Tentative Parcel Map is proposed to subdivide the Specific Plan area into 15 parcels and three lettered lots to facilitate future development in phases. A Site Plan Review is proposed for Phase I, comprised of six industrial buildings in the northern portion of the property and including: Building 1 (142,565 SF), Building 2 (147,145 SF), Building 3 (135,520 SF), Building 4 (680,420 SF), Building 5 (1,004,180 SF), and Building 6 (274,870 SF). Specific development plans for remaining phases are not proposed at this time.
