To Whom It May Concern:

The Shiloh Crossing Project Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration was circulated for public review at the Governor's Office and Planning and Research from September 2, 2022, to October 3, 2022, and at the Sonoma County Clerk's office from September 2, 2022, to October 1, 2022. The Town of Windsor received a comment letter from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) on October 5, 2022, requesting stronger mitigation measures for potential biological impacts.

The Town accepted CDFW's proposed modifications to Mitigation Measures BIO-1 (pre-construction surveys for burrowing owl) and BIO-2 (protection of active bird nests). On October 11, 2022, the Town of Windsor Planning Commission adopted the Shiloh Crossing Mitigated Negative Declaration and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) with revised Mitigation Measures BIO-1 and BIO-2 (see attached).
