The Box Springs Feeder shutdown project would involve lowering the water level in the Box Springs Feeder to facilitate critical repairs to the connected Santa Ana Valley Pipeline, owned and operated by the California Department of Water Resources. Dewatering activities are scheduled for November 2022 and February 2023. Water would be discharged from Station 88+40 into Sycamore Canyon Creek.
