**Project Title:** Castro Street Pedestrian Mall Study

**Schools within 2 miles:** Stevenson Elementary School, Waldorf School of the Penninsula, Gabriela Mistral Elementary School, Mariano Castro Elementary School, Mountain View Academy, Kahn Lan School, St Joseph Mountain View, Grahm Middle School, Mindful Montessori Landel Elementary school, and View High School

**Project Description:** The city intends to establish a pedestrian mall on the following three segments of Castro Street: (1) between West Evelyn Avenue (east leg) and Villa Street; (2) between Villa Street and Dana Street; and (3) between Dana Street and California Street. Vehicular through-traffic access on the cross-streets along Evelyn Avenue, Villa Street, Dana Street, and California Street will remain open. The city plans to utilize the pedestrian mall for outdoor dining, public use areas, special events and enhanced pedestrian circulation. Motor vehicle traffic will be prohibited on the proposed pedestrian malls except for emergency and utility maintenance vehicles.

To facilitate the project, the intersections of Castro/California, Castro/Dana and Castro/Villa will be modified to prohibit vehicles from accessing Castro Street and to improve the overall pedestrian experience.

There is no new development proposed as part of this project. The purpose of this analysis is to evaluate potential environmental impacts as a result of closing the above-described segments of Castro Street to vehicular traffic in order to create a pedestrian mall.
