DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to improve ingress/egress routes and defensible spaces in Jack London State Historic Park to facilitate firefighter access and operation in the event of future wildfire activity and to protect park resources. Work will be in the following areas:

- Wolf House Service Road
- Wolf House Ruins
- House of Happy Walls Museum
- Pig Palace/Smoke House
- Orchard Road
- Red Hill Road
- Lave Service Road/ Mountain Trail
- Vineyard Trail

Work will include thinning and/or removal of understory fuels, limbing of trees to up to 10-feet above ground level, removal of trees up to 10-inches DBH with overlapping or contiguous canopy, removal of standing dead trees, removal of fallen dead woody material, removal of trees with heavy lean over the road and maintenance of road edge clearance. All vegetation work in each area, especially around standing structures, will be reviewed in the field by a State Parks cultural resource specialist to ensure proper surveys are conducted and to discuss site specific treatment measures. Vegetation removal work will occur outside of migratory bird nesting season and no mature, healthy, scenic trees will be removed.
