All work will be confined within the existing roadbed hinge point. This project will include removal of thermoplastic pavement markings and a lead compliance plan will be developed. No work will take place on bridge decks and guardrail will not be replaced or upgraded. The project would be constructed in 2023 and take approximately 20 working days.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the project is to provide efficient, easily maintained pavement that provides minimum maintenance for multiple years, as well as increase safety for travelers and workers.

**Need:** The pavement has degraded to a point where maintenance is required to extend its service life.

#### Right-of-Way

Acquisitions or TCEs will not be needed for this project due to work being confined to ROW.

#### Staging/Stockpiling

Multiple locations are available for staging/stockpiling use. No grading and/or site preparation will occur. Approved staging locations include: PM 38.0 NB, PM 38.1 NB, PM 39.2 SB, PM 39.24 NB, PM 39.64 SB, PM 40.19 SB, PM 40.43 NB, PM 40.46 SB, PM 40.68 SB, PM 40.99 SB, PM 41.14 NB, PM 41.76-41.95 NB, PM 42.40 SB, PM 42.65-42.78 NB, PM 43.2 NB, PM 43.25 NB, PM 43.5 SB, PM 43.84 NB, PM 44.1 SB, PM 44.25 NB, PM 45.12-R45.89 SB.

#### **Disposal/Borrow Sites**

The project would not utilize borrowed material. The contractor will be responsible for disposal of excess material.

#### Coordination/Consultation

Caltrans has performed an environmental evaluation consisting of a review of resource records and databases, consultation, and coordination with applicable agencies and individuals, including the Native American Heritage Commission and local tribes.

#### **Permits**

No permits are anticipated based on the current scope of work.

#### **Utilities**

All utilities in proximity to the locations of work would be protected in place; no utility conflicts are anticipated.

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
