The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to construct a project to provide timely maintenance to prevent or delay the need for costly rehabilitation. The decking is exhibiting signs of wear. Methacrylate resin and polyester concrete overlays will preserve and extend the life of PCC bridge decks. Overlay removal and replacement requires replacement of joint seals to match final grade elevations. Failing oint seals require replacement. Cracks in soffit require epoxy injection to seal
