Project Description: Minor Subdivision application to subdivide an existing 20,000 square-foot parcel into 3 parcels. Parcel 1 to contain 5,600 square-feet. Parcel 2 to contain 6,700 square-feet. Parcel 3 to contain 7,200 square-feet. Access to Parcels 1 and 2 is proposed from Adelbert Ave. Access to Parcel 3 is proposed from Oro Ave. Public services are proposed for the 3 parcels. Will-serve letters have been submitted from California Water Service, the City of Stockton Department of Municipal Utilities for sewer, and San Joaquin County Department of Public Works for storm water drainage. This parcel is not under a Williamson Act Contract.

The Property is zoned R-L (Low Density Residential) and the General Plan designation is R/L (Low Density Residential).
