The Project facilitates the coordinated development of a residential community with a variety of single- and multi-family housing products and densities, recreational amenities, open spaces, pedestrian connectors, and a cohesive design program. Proposed architectural styles include Spanish Colonial, Progressive Spanish, Mid-Century, and Contemporary.
