Description of Activity	Due to Cross Valley Canal capacity limitations and to provide irrigation flexibility, Kern-Tulare Water District (KTWD) and Kern County Water Agency (KCWA) will conduct a bona fide water exchange through two water conveyances: (1) conveyance of up to 53,300 acre-feet of KCWA's State Water Project (SWP) 2022/2023 Table A water through KCWA's existing turnouts to KTWD, and (2) conveyance of a like amount of 2022 CVP water supplies to KCWA where the United States Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) will make KTWD's CVP water available to DWR at Banks Pumping Plant and/or O'Neill Forebay for DWR to deliver to KCWA.
