DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Place period appropriate banners and tents within Columbia State Historic Park in preparation of the Columbia Winterfest, a private sixweek long event in January, led by the Columbia Chamber of Commerce, to generate business for both the town and local economy during a traditionally slow period of visitation to the park. Work will:

- Erect three (3) canvas tents (two (2) 35-ft x 24-ft) and one (1) 44-ft x 38-ft) on pre-selected flat, dirt surfaces in the park, securing each corner with 18-inch hand forged tent stakes driven into the ground approximately 6 to 8-inches; and
- Use black paint to write the name of a theater on a 12-inch high canvas banner (same material as the tent) and hang one (1) banner above the entrance to each tent.
