The proposed project consists of the subdivision of approximately 37 gross acres for the construction and occupancy of 207 single-family residential lots in the R-7,000 (single family residential, minimum lot size 7,000 square feet) zone (TTM No. 53642). The applicant has also submitted a conditional use permit application (CUP No. 22-08) to allow for a residential planned development with smaller lots than the zoning would permit. The minimum lot size would be 4,250 square feet and the development would also provide approximately 5.89 acres of open space including paseos, recreational areas and green belts.
