The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace 22 culverts that have exceeded their design life expectancy along State Route 4 and State Route 49 in Calaveras and Tuolumne counties. The proposed culvert restoration methods include replacing the deteriorated culverts with reinforced concrete pipe; installing inlet and outlet end treatments consisting of flared end sections; installing concrete headwalls; installing concrete wing walls; and installing rock slope protection. The work will include excavating existing culverts; jacking-and-boring for deeper culverts; backfilling; concrete casing; paving; placing rock slope protection at outlets; repairing or replacing headwalls; and re-striping. Temporary construction easements and permanent right-of-way easements are anticipated at locations for construction and maintenance activities.
