Cal 4 Culvert Replacement Project

Do you want a virtual public hearing on changes proposed for Calaveras and Tuolumne counties?

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PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from October 20 to November 19, 2022.

If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace 22 culverts that have exceeded their design life expectancy along State Route 4 and State Route 49 in Calaveras and Tuolumne counties. Proposed culvert restoration methods include replacing the deteriorated culverts with

reinforced concrete pipe; installing inlet and outlet end treatments consisting of flared end sections; installing concrete headwalls; installing concrete wing-walls; and installing rock slope protection. The work will

include excavating existing culverts; jacking for deeper culverts; backfilling; concrete casing; paving; placing rock slope protection at outlets; and repairing or replacing headwalls; and restriping.

Temporary construction easements and permanent right-of-way easements are anticipated at locations for construction and maintenance activities

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment, as documented in a report called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you that the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration is now available for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a virtual public hearing.
