NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING & NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

On Wednesday morning, the 7th day of December 2022, at 9:00 a.m. at 1195 Third Street, Suite 305, Napa, California, a public hearing will be conducted by the Napa County Planning Commission regarding the project identified below. All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing and be heard.

Bella Union Winery - Major Modification #P19-00139

Location: 1695 State Highway 29/St. Helena Highway, Rutherford, CA 94573; APN: 027-470-007; 60.65 Acres **Zoning and General Plan Designation:** Agricultural Preserve (AP); Agricultural Resource (AR)

Request: Approval of a Major Modification to increase production, number of employees, and number of visitors. The project would modify the existing marketing plan, allow food and wine pairings with tastings, and permit onpremises consumption in additional areas on site. Physical changes on site include construction of an approximately 15,700 s.f. barrel storage and 2,000 s.f. office building, along with a 1,200 s.f. addition to the existing winery building, additional parking spaces, and associated site improvements. Improvements to the existing water and wastewater systems would be required.

CEQA Status: Consideration and possible adoption of a Negative Declaration. According to the proposed Negative Declaration, the proposed project would not have any potentially significant environmental impacts. The project site is not included on a list of hazardous materials sites compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.
