PROJECT TITLE: Tamarack Fire Grover Hot Springs Maintenance Yard Soil Testing

LOCATION: Grover Hot Springs State Park **COUNTY**: Alpine

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Conduct soil testing and percolation tests in and around the maintenance yard and residence areas in Grover Hot Springs State Park to identify soil conditions in the area to guide reconstruction and/or improvements proposed following the 2021 Tamarack Fire. Work will use a backhoe to excavate nine (9) 15-foot-long x 2-foot-wide x 10-foot-deep test pits and use a hand driven tube sampler to sample the pit soils. Representative soil samples will be recorded, and test pits will be back filled with excavated soils and tamped, in lifts, with the excavator bucket. Work will also perform three (3) percolation tests in the area of an existing leach field.
