Project Location: The project is located in Diggins Creek, tributary to Humbug Creek and the South Yuba River, in the County of Nevada, State of California; Latitude 39.36680, Longitude -120.92504; Assessor's Parcel Number 003-330-010-000. The Project area is approximately 105.4 acres of the former hydraulic mining pit (Pit) and Hiller Tunnel at Malakoff Diggins State Historic Park (MDSHP) located approximately nine miles northeast of Nevada City.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. NEV-30812-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Parks and Recreation, as represented by Joel Bonilla.

The project is limited to implementation of sediment best management practices (BMPs) to reduce discharge from the Pit into the South Yuba River watershed, control of non-native invasive species populations, and enhancement of habitat for special-status species, including species listed under the California Endangered Species Act (CESA).
