NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION MONTEREY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monterey County Housing & Community Development (HCD) has prepared a draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), for a Combined Development Permit (Feather Cypress LLC, File Number PLN210276) at 3356 17-Mile Drive, Pebble Beach, Del Monte Forest Land Use Plan, Coastal Zone (Assessor's Parcel Number 008-462-008-000) (see project description below).

The Monterey County Planning Commission will consider this proposal at a public hearing on a future date to be determined, in the Monterey County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 168 West Alisal, 2nd Floor, Salinas, California. Written comments on this Mitigated Negative Declaration will be accepted from November 21, 2022 to December 21, 2022. Comments can also be made during the public hearing.

Project Description: Combined Development Permit consisting of a Coastal Administrative Permit and Design Approval to allow the demolition of an existing single-family dwelling with attached two-car garage, a detached gym, covered walkway, sheds, and wall and gates; and the construction of a 7,767 square foot single-family dwelling with an attached two-car garage, and basement, 712 square foot pool house, 1,114 square foot pool, 140 square foot spa, and 524 linear feet of fencing and gates; a Coastal Development Permit to allow development within 750 feet of known archaeological resources; a Coastal Development Permit to allow development within 100 feet of an environmentally sensitive habitat area; and a Coastal Development Permit to allow development within 50 feet of a coastal bluff.
