Project Location (include county): (Project) is located north of Hercules St., west of Hesperia Road, south of Mojave Street, and directly east of Third Avenue within the City of Hesperia, San Bernardino County, California. The Project is located approximately 4 miles east of Interstate 15 at approximately (Latitude 34.434778, Longitude - 117.300778). The Project site is bounded by single family housing to the south and railroad tracks to the east.

Project Description: This proposed project involves the development of a new school campus would encompass the majority of the northern half of the 25.75 gross acres project site. The Project will consist of one main building, six relocatable classroom pods, parking lots, and a shallow infiltration basin for drainage. Project activities include grubbing and grading of the entire Project site, trench digging, pile driving, road construction, tree removal, and other activities.

The Project will result in impacts to 10.77 acres of western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*) habitat. The project is expected to result in incidental take of western Joshua tree, which is designated as a candidate threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
