PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Site Approval application for a 7,225-square-foot auto parts retail store. The project site proposes an access driveway from E. Blossom Ct., and another driveway from E. State Route 88. The project will be served by the Lockeford Community Services District for water and wastewater, and Counter Service Area (CSA) 52 for storm water. The project site is not under a Williamson Act Contract. (Use Type: Retail and Service – Intermediate)

The Property is zoned C-G (General Commercial) and the General Plan designation is C/G (General Commercial).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located on the northwest corner of E. Blossom Ct. and N. State Route 88 Highway, Lockeford. (APN/Address: 051-310-48 / 12999 E. Blossom Ct., Lockeford) (Supervisorial District: 4)
