Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The purpose of the Project is to restore fish passage at Bend Water Users' (BWU) diversion facilities and address mortality associated with the unscreened irrigation ditch for the benefit of juvenile and adult Central Valley steelhead, fall- / late fall-run Chinook salmon, and Pacific lamprey, while meeting the operational needs of BWU.

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, article 19, section 15333, Small Habitat Restoration Projects, which consists of projects not to exceed five acres to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of habitat for fish, plants, or wildlife.

Reasons why Project is Exempt:

This project is categorically exempt under CEQA section 15333 because the project's sole purpose is fish passage restoration and is less than 5 acres in size.
