Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Potential impacts to biological resources would be reduced to a less than significant level with implementation of Mitigation Measures BIO-1 through BIO-3. The Proposed Project is not anticipated to have the potential to significantly degrade the overall quality of the region's environment, or substantially reduce the habitat of a fish or wildlife species, cause a fish or wildlife population or drop below self-sustaining levels, threaten to eliminate a plant or animal community, reduce the number or restrict the range of a rare or endangered plant or animal. No significant impacts to cultural resources were identified in the Phase I Cultural Resources Investigation prepared for the Proposed Project. LSA Associates did not find any evidence of historical or prehistorical resources on the Project Site. However, implementation of Mitigation Measures CR-1, CR-2 and CR-3, TRC-1 and TRC-5 would ensure that the Proposed Project does not eliminate important examples of the major periods of California history or prehistory including tribal ancestral lands as identified during the tribal consultation process. Due to the presence of active and inferred faults in proximity to the Project site, the Project site is expected to experience occasionally moderate to severe ground shaking, as well as some background shaking from other seismically active areas of the Southern California region. Implementation of Mitigation Measures GEO-1, GEO-2 and GEO-3 will reduce the potential environmental effects due to geological hazards. Implementation of Mitigation Measures HAZ-1 would ensure that health impacts associated with hazardous materials in the existing site to construction workers and sensitive receptors would be less than significant. MMs HYD-1 through HYD-3 are prescribed to ensure proper engineering design and construction in conformance with the requirements of the County.

There is no public opposition from neighboring residents. The public was notified of the availability of the Initial Study/ Mitigated Negative Declaration, and given the opportunity to comment. All property owners will be notified with a hearing notice when the hearing for the project is scheduled.
