

## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR) AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

A Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the 210 Baypointe Residential Project (SCH# 2022120253). The approximately 4.3-acre project site is comprised of one parcel (APN: 097-07-046) located at 210 Baypointe Parkway, which is currently developed with a commercial building and associated parking lot. The proposed project would demolish the existing building on site and construct 42, three-story townhouses in six buildings and one 292-unit, seven story apartment building. Approximately 5.82 percent of total units within the apartment building would be affordable (17 units out of 292).

The proposed project will have potentially significant environmental effects with regard to air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, hazardous materials, and noise. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires this notice to disclose whether any listed toxic sites are present at the project location. The project location is located on the Cortese List of toxic sites for voluntary cleanup actions. The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is a responsible agency for this project.
