The project would involve demolition of the existing buildings, paving and private utilities onsite, removal of trees along the frontage facing Cedar Boulevard and vegetation on site, and construction of 118 units, incorporating single family residences and two-unit attached townhouses (duets), new landscaping, open space areas, and other associated improvements including utility upgrades and offsite improvements. The project would also involve rezoning the 7.76-acre project site from Residential Medium Density (RM) to Residential Medium Density-Planned Residential (RM-PD) overlay and subdividing the project site to create 124 lots.
