NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI) TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE CITY OF SOLVANG WASTEWATER TREATMENT WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

This Notice of Intent (NOI) is to inform the public and interested agencies that in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City of Solvang is circulating the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for public comment.

Project/Location: The City of Solvang is located at 101 Alisal Road, Solvang CA 93463 in Santa Barbara County on Rancho Alisal Drive along the Santa Ynez River.

Project Description: The proposed Wastewater Treatment Plant Water Quality Project is comprised of multiple improvements to restore lost treatment capacity, achieve required consistent removal of nitrogen, address existing Wastewater Treatment Plant deficiencies, and replace older facilities with improved technologies. The Project will result demolition of older structures, construction of new buildings, and renovations of some structures.

The Project includes improvements to restore lost treatment capacity, achieve required consistent removal of nitrogen, address existing WWTP deficiencies, and replace old facilities that have reached the end of their useful life. The improvements to restore lost capacity would also modify the treatment process to allow for production of recycled water. Computer models were developed, and simulations run to evaluate the treatment performance of various alternatives. Simulation results indicate that the alternatives would be capable of treating up to 1.5 MGD with the possibility of future expansion.
