This project is a General Plan Amendment to update the City of Fairfield (City) Housing Element for the planning period of 2023-2031 (hereafter, HEU). The proposed HEU is available at the city website, https://www.fairfieldforward.com/housing-element. This Initial Study evaluates the potential environmental impacts expected to result from adoption of the HEU. Through implementation of the housing programs, potential housing sites were identified in the Sites Inventory to show the City's ability to accommodate its RHNA allocation. Specifically, the HEU identifies that there are sufficient housing sites to accommodate its share of affordable housing through its inventory of potential housing sites located within vacant and underutilized non-vacant opportunity sites which promote infill development and are served by adequate infrastructure. The housing sites have been identified as part of the City's coordinated planning actions underway for the comprehensive update of the City's General Plan, which envisions new development concentrated in the downtown core (the Heart of Fairfield Specific Plan Area), near the Fairfield Train Station (Train Station Specific Plan area), near the Fairfield Transportation Center, along key corridors such as North Texas Street, and other infill areas throughout the City. These areas will contain a mix of uses around major streets with good access to transit and will include housing, employment, and neighborhood commercial uses.
