Project Title: 2023 Road Rehabilitation Project

Applicant: Yolo County

<u>Project Location</u>: The project affects approximately 18 miles of county roadway, including 4 miles on County Road (CR) 23 from CR 85B to CR 89, 8 miles on CR 24 from CR 90 to CR 98, 3.5 miles on CR 96 from Russell Blvd to .5 miles north of CR 29, and 2.7 miles of residential streets in the town of Esparto east of State Route 16 (Yolo Ave).

<u>Project Description</u>: The project involves pavement rehabilitation of approximately 18 miles of County Road (CR) 23, CR 24, CR 96, and streets east of SR 16 (Yolo Ave) in Esparto. CR 23, CR 24 and CR 96 will be treated by applying a double seal treatment on the existing road surface and the streets in Esparto will be primarily treated with a mill and fill. This is achieved first with base repairs (dig-outs) as needed, a microsurface treatment on the existing pavement surface followed by an asphalt rubber chip seal to complete the double seal treatment on CRs 23, 24, and 96. All construction will occur within the existing road prisms in the existing right-of-way; no widening, right of way acquisition or road capacity will occur. All the road dig-outs will be within existing structural sections. No trees will be removed as part of this project. The project will include a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and sediment control measures to address possible debris from construction operations.

Within east Esparto, the repairs will consist of a 3-4" mill and fill of hot mix asphalt on various residential streets (Woodland Ave, Capay St, N Grafton St, Grafton St, S Grafton St, Madison St, Plainfield St, Bonygne St, Winters St, Mattie St, and Alpha St), with additional base repairs on an approximately 1000-foot section of Alpha St. between Plainfield St and Grafton St.

<u>Exempt Status</u>: The project is categorically exempt from further environmental review based on Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

<u>Reasons why project is exempt</u>: Section 15301(c) allows a "Class 1" Categorical Exemption for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. A Class 1 exemption includes "Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety)." The project is for double sealing and repaving portions of CR 23, CR 24, CR 96, and residential streets in east Esparto that are currently paved and involves no increase in capacity of any existing roadway.
