NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Sacramento, State of California intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project described below.

Title: 7446 8th Street Parcel Map

Location: The project site is located on the southeast corner of U Street and 8th Street in the community of Rio

Linda.

General Description: The project consists of the following planning entitlement requests:

- 1. A **Tentative Parcel Map** to divide two parcels totaling approximately 7.33 gross (6.67 net) acres into four parcels:
 - Parcel 1 approximately 1.411 gross (1.002 net) acres
 - Parcel 2 approximately 1.24 gross (1.004 net) acres
 - Parcel 3 approximately 0.798 gross (0.691 net) acres
 - Parcel 4 approximately 3.998 gross (3.078 net) acres
- 2. A **Design Review** to determine substantial compliance with the *Sacramento County Countywide Design Guidelines* (Design Guidelines).

Proposed parcels 1, 2, and 3 contain existing homes and no development is proposed on these parcels at this time. Parcel 4 is currently undeveloped. While no development is proposed currently, future development of a residence on the parcel is anticipated and given the size of the parcel; an accessory dwelling unit (ADU) could also be developed.
