**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number NEV-33923-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Attila Hunyady.

The project is limited to the construction of a new pier. The new pier will consist of 10 3/4" diameter pilings driven 6' into the lakebed. Each piling will have 4x6x3/16 steel joists supported by steel beams. Caissons will be installed around the pilings. Trex decking will be used for the decking surface. There will be 6.3 square feet of permanent impact to the lakebed. All debris and staging will be contained on a floating amphibious barge.
