**Location:** The project site is located at 7340 28th Street, approximately 950 feet north of Q Street, in the North

Highlands community

**APN:** 208-0071-008

**General Description:** The proposed project is a request for a grading permit on a 9.8 acre parcel in the North Highlands community. The entire parcel is proposed to be graded with the amount of material to be cut estimated at 10,653 cubic yards and the amount to be filled estimated at 10,546 cubic yards. The amount of cut and fill are approximately balanced on the site. However, it should be noted that the calculation of cut and fill was done using land desktop volume calculator from existing grade and proposed finish grade terrain models, using the grid method. Exact excavation volume will be determined at time of field excavation. The proposed grading activity supports future development of the site consistent with County zoning regulations.
