Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-35320 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Daniel Stillion.

The project is limited to the removal of three existing steel pilings and two concrete columns, as well as the installation of 8 new 8-foot pilings to build a 16-foot-wide by 16-foot-long deck and 21-foot wide by 30-foot-long boat lift. The existing pilings and columns will be removed, and new pilings driven during the dry season.
