

## CEQA Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15072 and Public Resources Code Section 21092, the **City of Trinidad** is providing notice of intent to adopt an initial study (IS) and mitigated negative declaration (MND) for the "**Trinidad Water Storage Tank and Pipeline Replacement Project**" as described here.

**Project Description:** The City of Trinidad proposes to replace 1.4 miles of vulnerable pipelines and construct a 300,000-gallon storage tank and chlorination booster system for the City of Trinidad to enhance water availability during drought conditions.

<u>Public Review Period for the IS/MND</u>: The public is invited to comment on the proposed IS/MND pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. The review period set by the City of Trinidad for review of the IS/MND is 30 days.
